1	What is Al-Quran?	Al-Quran is 'kalamullah' or 'the speech of Allah' which was sent down to the last Prophet Muhammad (S) through the angel Jibreel (A) and protected by Allah from any corruption or loss.
2	In which language was the Quran revealed?	Arabic
3	Who brought down the revelation to our Prophet (S)?	Angel Jibreel (A)
4	How many chapters (Surah) are there in the Holy Quran?	114
5	How many Juz is the Holy Quran divided into?	30 Juz
6	What is the first and last Surah of the Quran called?	Surah Al-Fatihah is the first surah and Surah an-Naas is the last.
7	Allah has many names. Mention some of Allah's names mentioned in the Quran with meaning.	Ar-Rabb (The Master), Ar-Rahman (The Most Beneficent), Ar-Raheem (The Most Merciful), Al-Malik (The Sovereign), Al-Quddus (The Pure), As-Salam (The Perfect), Al-Mu'min (The Giver of Security), Al-Azeez (The All-Mighty), Al-Jabbar (The Compeller- the one who restores completely), Al-Hakeem (The All-Wise) etc.
8	What are some ways of preserving the Quran?	Memorization by heart, writing, printing etc.
9	Who ordered to compile the Quran completely in written form as one book?	Abu Bakr (R), the first Caliph in Islam.
10	What is Laylatul Qadr? Why is it important?	Laylatul Qadr or Night of Power is a night from last 10 nights of the month of Ramadan. This is the night when Allah started revelation of the Quran upon our Messenger (S). Ibadah of this night is better than thousands night in the eye of Allah Subhanahu ta'ala. Also, the angels along with angel Jibreel (alaihi salam) comes down to the earth in this night and destinies are decided during the nighttime.

11	How was the Quran revealed to the Prophet (S)?	The most common method was Allah (SWT) asked angel Jibreel (A) to carry the messages to Prophet Muhammad (S).
12	Why has Allah sent down the Quran to us?	Ayah 2 of Surah Al-Baqarah says: (ذَلِكَ الْكِتَابُ لَا رَيْبَ فِيهِ هُدًى لِّلْمُتَّقِينَ) meaning: "That is the Book (the Quran); has no doubts in it at all; it is a guidance for the muttaqoon (who fears Allah)." According to this Ayah, Al-Quran has been sent down to us as the "huda or hidayah" (guidance) in our life.
13	What is the greatest ayah of the Quran? Mention some virtues of this ayah.	Ayatul Kursi (Ayah 255 of Surah Baqarah) is the greatest ayah of the Quran. Some of its virtues according to Hadith are 1) If one recites Ayatul Kursi when lies down in bed, a protector is appointed for him from Allah and no shaytaan (devil) will come near to him until morning comes. 2) Whoever recites Ayatul Kursi immediately after each prescribed prayer, there will be nothing standing between him and his entering Paradise except death. 3) Whoever recites Ayatul Kursi, it will protect him from Jinn.
14	Which surah will protect one from the Dajjal?	According to Hadith: Whoever memorizes the first (or last) ten Ayat of the Surat Al-Kahf, will be protected from (the trial of) Ad-Dajjal. (Muslim)
15	Name some of the names of the Quran with meaning.	Some names of the Quran: Al-Furqan (the distinguisher between right and wrong), Kitabullah (the book of Allah), Kalamullah (the words of Allah), Tajkirah (reminder), Zikr (reminder) and Kitab (scripture), Tanjeel (revelation), Huda (hidayah) etc.
16	What is the dua for increasing knowledge?	Allah taught the dua in Ayah 114 of Surah Taha: (وَقُلْ رَبِّ زِدْنِي عِلْمًا) meaning: "And say: "My Lord! Increase me in knowledge." "

17	How are the surah of the Quran classified based on the time of revelation?	Based on the time of revelation, the surahs of the Quran are classified into two groups - Makki surah and Madani surah. The surahs that are revealed before the hijrah of the Prophet (S) are known as Makki surah and those revealed after hijrah are known as Madani surah.
18	Which place has been called 'Al-Balad Al-Ameen' (The secure city) in the Quran?	Makkah
19	What should we do to attain Allah's love?	Allah says in Ayah 31 of Surah Ale Imran: قُلْ إِنْ كُنْتُمْ تُحِبُّونَ اللَّهَ فَاتَّبِعُونِي يُحْبِبْكُمُ اللَّهُ وَيَغْفِرْ لَكُمْ ذُنُوبَكُمْ ۗ وَاللَّهُ غَفُورٌ رَحِيمٌ meaning: "Say (O Muhammad S to mankind): "If you (really) love Allah then follow me (i.e. accept Islamic Monotheism, follow the Quran and the Sunnah), Allah will love you and forgive you of your sins. And Allah is Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful." "
20	What is the best deed after ibadah of Allah according to the Quran?	Allah instructed us in Ayah 23 of Surah Al-Israa: وَقَضَىٰ رَبُّكَ أَلَّا تَعْبُدُوا إِلَّا إِيَّاهُ) (وَبِالْوَالِدَيْنِ إِحْسَانًا) meaning: "And your Lord has decreed that you worship none but Him. And that you treat your parents with ihsan (excellent manners)."
21	Which act is compared to eating the flesh of one's dead brother?	According Ayah 12 of Surah Hujurat, geabah (backbiting) is the sin that are compared to eating flesh of one's dead brother.
22	What were the first verses revealed to the Prophet (S)?	Verses 1-5 of Surah Al-Alaq: اقْرَأْ بِاسْمِ رَبِّكَ الَّذِي خَلَقَ - خَلَقَ الْإِنْسَانَ مِنْ عَلَقٍ - اقرأ وربك - الذي علم بالقلم - علم الإنسان ما لم يعلم meaning: "Recite in the name of your Lord who created - Created man from a clinging substance. Recite, and your Lord is the most Generous - Who taught by the pen - Taught man that which he knew not."

23	Mention some rewards of memorizing the Quran.	<p>Whoever memorizes the Quran and acts upon it, Allaah will reward him and honour him greatly for that. Some of the rewards of memorizing the Quran are -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) The best of people is the one who learns the Quran and teaches it.2) It will be said to the companion of the Quran (in Akhirah): Recite and rise in status (in Jannah), recite as you used to recite in the world, for your status will be at the last verse that you recite.3) The likeness of the one who reads Quran and memorizes it is that he will be with the righteous honourable scribes (from Angels).4) The Quran will intercede for him on the Day of Resurrection.5) Memorizing Quran will keep a person close to the guidance from Allah and reciting it will increase his iman.6) It gives the great opportunity to be one of Allah's means in protecting the Quran.
